

Southern Region THS
Shiphay Farm, Colyton
14th June to 12th July



The site lies just on the edge of the small town of Colyton, which is rather lovely with a beautiful church, old buildings and narrow little streets. The river Coly runs around the town and on down to Colyford.

There are a few shops in the town, which should provide all the groceries you need, a post office and a bike shop. There's a tearoom just over the road from the campsite which serves sandwiches, ice creams and cream teas. Opposite the tearoom is a small roadside stall selling beans, tomatoes and other home-grown produce (seasonal). There are available walking tours around the older part of the village telling the history of the buildings and people of Colyton, The seaside towns of Seaton & Beer are about 2.5-3mils away. There is a walk to Seaton or you can take the Tramway, the station is only a short distance from site. Also within the area are Honiton, Axminster and Lyme Regis. There are several activities for all, bike trails, walk the Jurassic coast, visit Axe Valley wildlife park, Shute Barton medieval house, Seaton Wetlands nature reserve, or take a trip on the Seaton tramway. Whatever you want there is something for everyone.

Cost per unit night is only £8.50 and if you wish to bring an extra adult (members only) it's only £3.00 per unit night.
